## Domestic Violence Incentive?

By having a practice nurse or Aboriginal Health Worker complete the **free on line training package**, your practice could benefit from this Practice Incentives Program (PIP) payment.

The course will upskill the practice nurse or AHW, which in turn allows PIP eligible practices to apply for incentive payments.

### Guidelines for the PIP Domestic Violence Incentive:

### Nurses and AHW will be able to:

- **Recognise** the language and behaviour which may indicate a person is experiencing domestic and family violence
- **Respond** to people experiencing domestic and family violence by being able to listen, believe and validate their experience
- **Refer** patients experiencing domestic and family violence to relevant local support services
- Conduct a risk assessment
- Be aware of the regulatory requirements in relation to child protection issues
- Use appropriate interpersonal skills and general knowledge to identify and respond in an appropriate manner to domestic and family violence
- Explore issues relevant to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.
